

Replacement Light Seal Kit For Olympus Trip 35

Fitting Instructions

The first step to replacing your light seals is to clean off the old deteriorated light seals found along the inside of the back door hinge and in the thin channels.

(See photo opposite to help locate these areas marked in red)

There are various methods for doing this and it is well documented on the internet but we recommend using an Acetone Free Nail Polish Remover and a cotton tip, (Q-tip) both of which are available at all good health and beauty shops. Using the Q-tip apply the nail polish remover where the old light seals are. This will help to soften and remove the old seals, any debris and excess cleaner can be cleaned off using a clean cloth.



Once cleaned, its time to place the new light seals in the same place as the old ones.

You will notice that there are two very thin strips included in the kit, these go top and bottom in the thin channels. To do this first remove the self adhesive protective strip and using the small wooden tool to place the strips in the channel sticky side down. This can be tricky so care is needed to gently push down the new strips.

Peel the protective strip off the large piece of new light seal foam included in the kit and place along the inside edge against the hinge, sticky side down.



Congratulations you have just replaced your light seals! Next to load your camera with some 35mm film and have years of fun with your Olympus Trip 35.
